ICT FOR GRUNDTVIG COURSES

Organizing and conducting Grundtvig courses is a very challenging activity.

The courses are short, often a few days, the participants come from very different cultures and educational traditions, they have different experiences and work with very different groups of adults.

Furthermore the topics addressed in Grundtvig courses are often complicated and there is a long way from theory to practice.

These obstacles might be addressed in pre-course and post-course phases, surrounding the face-to-face course itself.

This is why we wish to use ICT in Grundtvig courses.

Using ICT for communication, information, material and dialogues might contribute considerably to increase the quality and outcomes of a Grundtvig course, as ICT can help preparing the course and bridge between course theory and everyday adult education practice.

The keynote will discuss some of the most important elements in integrating ICT and will link the use of ICT to what we call Grundtvig course didactics.
